

Jacaranda is now open.

Over the past 8 months, a lot has happened to make pasture land into the last 5 holes of the Jacaranda course.

- ✓ First, the land was cleared.
- ✓ Next, the area was rough graded with irrigation, drainage, and cart paths were installed as in the photo to the left.
- ✓ The next step was to shape out greens, tees, bunkers and mounds. Greens were hollowed out and drainage was added in preparation for the base greens mix. Bunkers were also hollowed out and drainage added before the white sand was installed. Tees and mounds were shaped and the final grade began.



- ✓ It was then time to start planting, fertilizing and watering the course. After the turf became established and firm, mowing began. All heights were maintained higher and were brought down gradually as the areas fill in.
- ✓ Fairways were mowed following the design lay out of the course. During the last stages of the grow-in, the trees and landscape were added to complete the design of the course.



The course is now ready, the final touches are complete, all of the things that have brought the course up to the high standards of The Villages so golfers can test their skills in safe and beautiful surroundings have been completed. We know that you will enjoy the final nine holes of the Cane Garden Country Club and we ask that you will help us maintain the course by fixing ball marks and avoiding high golf cart traffic areas.
