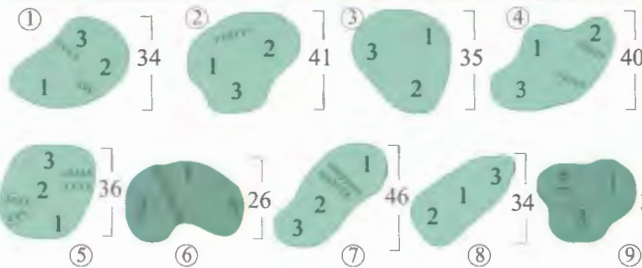

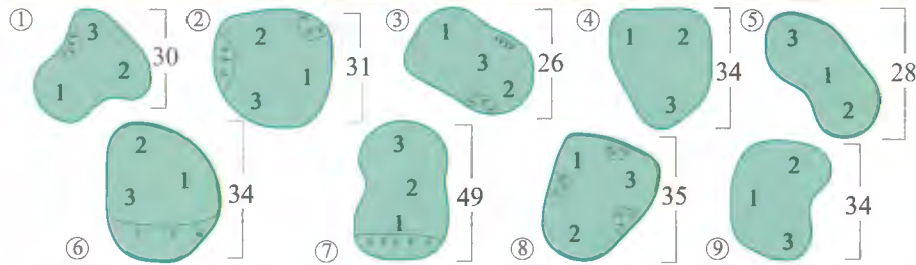

USGA RULES WILL GOVERN ALL PLAY ALONG WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES.

- **Out of Bounds** is defined by:
 1. The inside edge of white stakes or lines, villa walls, and wooden fences.
 2. In the absence of stakes, the inside edge of street curbs, paved public roads, or transportation trails.
- **Water Hazards** are defined by Yellow Stakes or Lines.
- **Lateral Water Hazards** are defined by Red Stakes or Lines.
- **Environmentally Restricted Areas** are marked as water or lateral water hazards and are identified by green-topped stakes. Golfers are not allowed to enter these areas for any reason including playing or retrieving their golf ball, and must proceed with the options available under rule 26-1. In addition, you may not stand inside the margins of environmental area to play a ball lying outside the area. You must take free and complete relief from the environmental area in this instance as outlined in appendix 1 Part B.
- **150-Yard Posts** are movable obstructions.
- **The Embedded Ball Rule** is in effect "through the green".
- **Ground Under Repair**, which allows free relief under the following conditions:
 1. Areas enclosed by white lines.
 2. Any unusual damage caused by maintenance vehicles, golf carts or the like.
 3. Any newly sodded areas; relief is permitted for the lie of the ball only.
 4. Flower and/or shrub beds (does not include cord grass beds) (**RELIEF IS MANDATORY**)
 5. Staked Trees and/or built up tree wells.
- In the event of an odd course handicap, the extra stroke is applied to the first nine played.
- Devices used for measuring yardages, such as Golf Buddy, are permitted to be used during normal play or any Villages sponsored tournament.
- The Scoring Area is deemed to be the entire clubhouse grounds.
- Scorecard playoffs for all Villages sponsored events will be broken by the USGA Rules of Golf, Appendix 1.

Etiquette

- Time Par is 4 hours & 16 minutes.
- Please observe The Village's dress code.
- Maximum two people per cart & each player must have their own clubs.
- Please repair ball marks on the greens, rake bunkers, and fill divots in the fairways with sand provided to you.
